BIBLE 121 - New Testament Survey: The Epistles and Revelation

This course, which covers the books of Romans through Revelation, requires an in-depth reading of the new testament text, along with textbook readings explaining the historical and theological significance of these biblical texts. There will also be an emphasis on the lives and ministries of the apostolic writers. Students will gain an intimate familiarity with the epistles and learn to apply these truths to their ministry callings and settings. The course will be structured with weekly lectures and personal discipleship. Evaluation will be gained from weekly quizzes, two written papers, a midterm, and a final exam.

- *Instructor Profile:* Paul Manwiller grew up in Anchorage, Alaska. He went to the University of Michigan and later Wayne State University to earn his bachelor's in education. He went on to earn his Master of Divinity from Trinity Evangelical Divinity School in Deerfield Illinois. He has been a pastor for over 30 years first in a bush village in Alaska and then in church planting efforts in the Detroit area. Since 1993, he has served as the founding pastor of Hope Community Church in Ypsilanti Michigan.
- *Instructor Profile:* Daniel Manwiller earned his bachelor's in electrical engineering and his master's in electrical and computer engineering from the University of Michigan. During his time at the University of Michigan, he served as an undergraduate instructional assistant and later as a graduate student instructor for an engineering design course. He currently works in an engineering role and serves in various ministry roles at Hope Community Church. Additionally, he is pursuing a master's in biblical studies from Moody Theological Seminary.

HISTORY 110 – Church History

This course is a panoramic survey of the past two millennia of church history. It includes an emphasis on original sources, expansion of the worldwide church, key people, theological debate and development, and major movements and influences that have shaped the current church. It also includes a landscape of the famous church councils and a brief history of the English Bible. Also, the Student will benefit from a thorough video series on the early English Bibles. The applicational value of Church History will be constantly included in both the history and theology discussions and debates. Evaluation will be based on weekly open-book quizzes and 3 exams.
